## Clothing

We ask that parents ensure that their child is prepared for types of weather - hot, cold, dry or wet.

Spring or rain jackets, hats, gloves, rubber boots and splash pants are some of the things that can help your child make the most of their outdoor experience while remaining comfortable. Be mindful for colder mornings when snow suits are still needed.

Please check your child's clothing bin (located in the cupboard under the change table in the washroom) for seasonally appropriate clothing and replace any items your child may have outgrown.



If your child is potty training, we recommend at least 3 - 4 pairs of underwear, pants, socks and 1 - 2 extra pairs of shoes.
