

OUTSIDE TIME

On days without field trips, the children will be outside at the Fairgrounds, exploring our community on walks or the playground. On days when the humidex is high or the air quality is poor, we will adjust our schedule to spent more time outside in the morning. The staff are trained to monitor the children and watch for changing weather conditions. Water is always provided for all outings.



To advance literacy throughout the summer, we request each child bring a book to read during quiet time after lunch. When possible, please alternate the books coming to our classroom so that the children can experience different books all summer long.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trips begin the week of July 9th and run until the week of August 20th.

Trip permission forms will be sent out shortly. Please sign and return as soon as possible.

A notice with trip details will be posted next to the parent sign in /out attendance area.

SUNSCREEN

Please remember to apply sunscreen on your child every morning before drop off. The staff will re-apply it in the afternoon.



Splash pad days are on Wednesdays. The children will be transported in one of our vans. Please provide a bathing suit, towel and shoes (water shoes or closed toe shoes with a heel strap) in a bag to be kept at the Centre. For safety reasons, no flip flops or bare feet at the splash pad.



THINGS TO REMEMBER

- * Any items requested for "Bring something from home" days such as electronics, games, books, etc. should be labeled with your child's name and taken home daily.
- * If your child will be absent, please call to inform us at 905-877-5004 ext. 17.
- * If there are any changes to your child's information sheet regarding address, contact phone numbers, allergies, etc., please request a "Change of Information" form to complete and return.
- * Please provide your child with a sunhat everyday for our outings.
- * Proper footwear is required. Shoes with closed toe, heel strap and a non-slip sole for outside time. Running shoes are the preferred footwear. Running shoe must be worn when we are walking to the fairgrounds.
