ATTENDANCE

It is important that you sign your child **in and out** every day.

If your child will not be attending, please phone our classroom. We are finding that the internet is sometimes not working and we do not receive messages until later in the day.



ART

Each child has a place on our creative shelf for their art. Please check it daily.



Hand washing stops the spread of germs.

Please have your child wash their hands upon entering the classroom.



NO FOOD OR DRINKS are to be brought into the centre.

CLOTHING

Please check our child's ziplock to ensure your child has 2 sets of seasonally appropriate clothing (pants, tops, socks and underwear).

ILLNESS & MEDICATION

If your child feels unwell while at day care, a teacher will give parents a courtesy call and we will monitor your child.

If your child experiences a fever (higher than 100.4°) or 2 bouts of diarrhea or vomiting, it will be necessary for your child to be picked up.

Your child may return to daycare once he/she is symptom free for 24 hours or after 24 hours of starting a medication.



Please do not park in tenant parking spaces, or between the buildings when dropping off or picking up.



LATE FEE is \$5.00 per minute per child if you arrive after 6:00 p.m.

If you are making alternate pick up arrangements, please ensure you contact the Centre and the person has photo ID.



OUTSIDE TIME

During the winter months, we will continue to go outside twice a day unless a cold weather alert has been issued. We will monitor the children to ensure no one feel any ill effects from the weather. Please provide a second pair of mittens as we are finding that mittens from the morning are not dry enough for our afternoon outside time.



CUBBIES

With all our bulky outer wear, we are finding we need every bit of extra space thus allowing snow suits to dry completely. The only items that should be in your child's cubby should be their snow suit, a hat, 2 pairs of mittens, and a ziplock bag with their spare clothes. So please do not bring any extra items such as backpacks, bags, toys, etc. Please label all of your child's belongings.

BLANKETS

We are finding that some of the children have out grown their blankets, their blankets are too small. Please have a look at your child's blanket to ensure we can cover them up properly. The Health department has asked us to send blankets home weekly for cleaning.
